WHEREAS, the purpose of such closed meeting is to conduct privileged and confidential communications concerning documents related to a negotiated contract that has not been executed; and,

WHEREAS, such closed meeting is allowable under section 610.021(12) of the Revised Statutes of Missouri; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature be

authorized to hold a closed meeting during the regularly scheduled meeting of the Legislature on Monday, October 23, 2023, pursuant to section 610.021(12), RSMo, and closing all records prepared in connection therewith.
