IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION granting a one-year waiver of the residency requirement for non-merit employees for Assistant Prosecuting Attorney David Fry pursuant to § 730., Jackson County Code.

RESOLUTION #12992, December 13, 1999

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, § 730 of the Jackson County Code requires all officers and employees of the County to be residents of Jackson County, Missouri, and sets forth procedures for the waiver of same by the County Legislature in the case of non-merit employees; and,

WHEREAS, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney David Fry has requested a waiver of said residency requirement; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has set forth facts tending to show a hardship on the part of said employee and that it would be in the best interest of the County if a waiver of the residency requirement were to be granted; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature does hereby waive the residency requirement of non-merit employee David Fry based upon his showing of hardship and further based upon the best interests of Jackson County for one-year from the date of adoption of this Resolution.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
