## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the exemption of the position of Clerk, within the office of the COMBAT Commission, from the provisions of the Merit System, and amending Schedule V to Chapter 2, Jackson County Code, 1984, relating to the salaries of non-merit employees. ORDINANCE 2786, March 2, 1998

## INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the COMBAT Commission has requested that the Commission's clerk, a new position, be exempt from the provisions of the Merit System; and,

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting of February 4, 1998, the Merit System considered this request and, pursuant to Article IX, § 2 of the Constitutional Home Rule Charter of Jackson County, has recommended this exemption to the Legislature; and,

WHEREAS, since the position of clerk is new for 1998, it is necessary for the Legislature to establish a salary range for that position pursuant to Article II, 16 (15) of the Charter, and 287 of the County Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Personnel Director recommends that, inasmuch as the position of clerk would be a grade 6 position were it within the Merit System, it should receive the same non-merit range; and,

WHEREAS, the adoption of this ordinance is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that, pursuant to Article IX, § 2 of the Charter, the exemption of the position of clerk within the office of the COMBAT Commission from the provisions of the Merit System, be and hereby is authorized; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Schedule V to Chapter 2, Jackson County Code, 1984 be and hereby is amended as follows: SCHEDULE V
