IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION urging the County administration to take charge of the relocation of the Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners.

RESOLUTION # 11043, December 4, 1995

INTRODUCED BY James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, certain orders in the case of Hall v. Jackson County Department of Corrections, no. 84-1200-CV-W-1, United States District Court for the Western District of Missouri, require the County to convert the building now occupied by the Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners into a correctional facility; and,

WHEREAS, this conversion will require that the Board and its staff relocate; and,

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the court's ordered time schedule in the Hall case, it is essential that the Board's relocation be completed by March 1, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Board have yet to agree on a new location for the Board; and,

WHEREAS, in order to ensure compliance with the court's order, and to minimize the budgetary implications the relocation will have on the County, it is appropriate that the County administration take charge of and oversee the relocation; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature urges the County administration to take charge of and oversee the relocation of the Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners, in coordination with the City of Kansas City, and subject to final approval by the Legislature.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
