WHEREAS, Section 1030.1, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when items or services to be purchased can be obtained from only one source and requires notification of and approval by the Legislature on such sole source purchases exceeding \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends a twelve-month term and supply contract with DCT Solutions Group of Kansas City, MO, for the furnishing of laser radio terminals, accessories, maintenance and repair for use by the Department of Corrections; and,

WHEREAS, the Director further recommends that he not take competitive bids with regard to said contract for the reason that DCT Solutions Group of Kansas City, MO, is the only certified, local distributor of Symbol Technologies equipment; now therefore,
