WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has solicited formal written bids on Bid No. 2-98 for the furnishing of paint and painting supplies for use county-wide; and,
WHEREAS, following evaluation of the bids submitted, the Purchasing Director recommends that the contract be divided and awarded to the vendors submitting the lowest bid for each item; and,
WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in estimated awards to the following vendors: VENDOR AWARD Sherwin Williams Co. \$15,000.00 Kansas City (Jackson County), MO
Davis Paint Co. \$15,000.00 Kansas City (Clay County), MO

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,
