WHEREAS, Tom was a involved in a number of organizations such as the following: Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity, Phi Alpha Delta Legal Fraternity, Native Sons of Greater Kansas City, and the Lee's Summit Optimist Club; and,

WHEREAS, Tom was also a member of the Summit Democratic Club for many years, actively
