IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION authorizing the purchase of proprietary novelty items for resale by the Parks and Recreation Department at the various marinas from Anderson Wholesale of Muskogee, OK, in the estimated amount of \$9,000.00. RESOLUTION #12579, March 15, 1999

INTRODUCED BY Fred Arbanas, County Legislator

WHEREAS, § 1040.6 of the Jackson County Code, 1984, dispenses with the requirement of competitive bidding for the purchase of proprietary articles, i.e. goods manufactured under an exclusive individual right to make and sell them, which are to be offered for resale at certain retail outlets operated by the Parks and Recreation Department; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 1040.6, the Purchasing Director recommends the issuance of a purchase order to Anderson Wholesale of Muskogee, OK, for the furnishing of proprietary novelty items to be offered for resale by the Parks and Recreation Department at the various marinas, in the total amount of \$9,000.00; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the Purchasing Director be and hereby is authorized to issue a purchase order in the amount of \$9,000.00 to Anderson Wholesale of Muskogee, OK; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make all payments including final payment on the contract thereby made...Attorney
