### IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** awarding a term and supply contract on Bid No. 37-01 for the furnishing of inmate clothing for use by the Corrections Department to Uniforms Manufacturing of Scottsdale, AZ (\$19,080.66), Tabb Textiles of Opelika, AL (\$35,137.00), ICS of Waco, TX (\$2,092.00), Hamilton Uniforms of Crosswicks, NJ (\$1,770.10), Bob Barker, Inc., of Fuquay-Varina, NC (\$7,407.00), and ATD American of Wyncote, PA (\$8,256.60), to provide for departmental needs for the upcoming one-year period, in the estimated aggregate amount of \$73,743.36.
