BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature

hereby does authorize the County Counselor to settle of the claim of Audrey Barber in the case of

Barber v. Jackson County, No. 05-818-CV-W-REL, now pending in the United States District Court

for the Western District of Missouri, for a lump sum payment in the amount of \$50,000.00, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance and Purchasing be and

hereby is authorized to make all payments required by this Resolution pursuant to the specific

direction of the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Counselor and any other County officials be and

hereby are authorized to execute any and all other documents necessary to give full legal effect to

this Resolution.
