WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement sets forth the mutual responsibilities and obligations of				
the parties for the services described above; and,				
WHEREAS, this Agreement is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the County; now therefore,				
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive				
be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of				
Independence, Missouri, for animal control field services and animal control sheltering services, and				
for the construction of the shared sheltering facility.
