steps to prevent and control heart disease risk factors; and,

WHEREAS, women's health remains a priority for families, communities, and government, and our commitment to keeping women healthy is stronger than ever; and,

WHEREAS, The Heart Truth campaign and its Red Dress symbol are building awareness of women's heart disease risks and empowering them to reduce their risk and prevent heart disease; and, WHEREAS, Samuel U. Rodgers Health Center is working in conjunction with The Heart Truth campaign to spread awareness of women's heart health issues in Jackson County and Kansas City by hosting the Heart Health Souper Seminar lunch event on February 4, 2011; now therefore,
