ORDINANCE #4415, May 21, 2012

INTRODUCED BY James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force has received a grant from the United States Office of National Drug Control Policy, High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) program in the amount of \$75,000.00, to provide funding for undercover operations by detectives working with the Drug Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the grant is awarded for the period of January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2012;
and,

WHEREAS, the attached Memorandum of Understanding with the Missouri State Highway Patrol,
which will serve as the Fiscal Agent for this grant, provides a suitable mechanism by which to
implement this arrangement; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place these grant funds in the appropriate spending
accounts; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following
