WHEREAS, the Fort Osage School District shall reimburse the County for the services rendered by

the School Resource Officer in the yearly amount of \$79,653.91 for the period of July 1, 2013,

through June 30, 2014; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive

be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the attached cooperative agreement with the Fort Osage

School District.
