INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the voters of Jackson County, Missouri, renewed the sales tax to provide funding for the

fight against illegal drugs and violent crime in our community; and,

WHEREAS, the proceeds and interest generated from this tax are deposited in a special Jackson

County Anti-Drug Sales Tax Trust Fund that is segregated and not commingled with the general fund

or any other special funds of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the voters and the Legislature authorized the Jackson County Drug Commission, subject

to approval by the Legislature, to contract with any organization or entity, whether public or private,

which engages in community crime prevention activities, for the purpose of preventing drug use and

drug-related offenses; and,

WHEREAS, this award was based on the Commission's recommendations after an independent

review of proposals submitted by outside agencies pursuant to Request for Proposal 59-13; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission has recommended that the County Executive be authorized to execute

agreements with certain outside agencies engaged in anti-drug and/or anti-violent crime prevention

activities for services from January 1, 2014, to December 31, 2014; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies, in the amounts indicated

on the document attached hereto as Exhibit A, is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and

safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,
