ORDINANCE NO. 4658, September 2, 2014

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Task Force (JCDTF) and the U.S. Department of Justice's

Drug Enforcement Administration have formed the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) to conduct a joint federal drug investigation, OCDETF Case No. WC-KS-181, Operation Puma Blanco, for the period of June 1, 2014, through September 30, 2014; and,

WHEREAS, the overtime costs incurred by the JCDTF for this investigation will be reimbursed by the OCDETF, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the projected funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the undesignated fund balance of the 2014 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund be and hereby is made:
