RESOLUTION NO. 18730, February 17, 2015

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the voters of Jackson County, Missouri, renewed the sales tax to provide funding for the fight against illegal drugs and violent crime in our community; and,

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WHEREAS, the proceeds and interest generated from this tax are deposited in a special Jackson

County Anti-Drug Sales Tax Trust Fund that is segregated and not commingled with the general fund

or any other special funds of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the voters and the Legislature authorized the Drug Commission, subject to approval by

the Legislature, to contract with any organization or entity, whether public or private, which engages

in anti-drug and anti-violent crime treatment activities; and,

WHEREAS, by Request for Proposals 76-14, the Drug Commission solicited proposals from

community agencies seeking to provide anti-drug and anti-violent crime treatment activities and

services for the two-year period 2015-2016; and,

WHEREAS, these proposals were evaluated by outside experts who made funding recommendations

to the commission: and.

WHEREAS, after review of the outside evaluators recommendations, the Jackson County Drug

Commission has recommended that the County Executive be authorized to execute agreements with

certain outside agencies engaged in anti-drug and anti-violent crime treatment activities for services

from January 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies, in the amounts indicated

on the document attached hereto as Exhibit A, is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and

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safety of the citizens of Jackson County;	now therefore,
