**RESOLUTION NO. 18744, March 2, 2015**

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended that the County Executive be authorized to execute agreements with certain outside agencies engaged in anti-drug and anti-violent crime law enforcement, treatment, and prevention activities, requiring a local match to grant funds,

for services from January 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission's applications are based on reviews by independent evaluators of applications submitted by the outside agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies, in the amounts indicated on the document attached hereto as Exhibit A, is in the best interest of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer is necessary to place a portion of the funds needed in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer within the 2015 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund be and hereby is made:
