and/or anti-violent crime prevention and treatment activities and purposes, through December 31,

2014; and,

WHEREAS, the COMBAT staff has recommended that the County Executive be authorized to extend

for an additional six months, through June 30, 2015, the existing agreements of the outside agencies

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreements.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
