WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4636, dated June 30, 2014, and Ordinance 4695, dated November 20, 2014, the Legislature did authorize the implementation of revisions to Chapter 6 of the Jackson County Code related to Women- and Minority-owned business contracting practices; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Kansas City, Missouri, is undertaking a disparity study of the contracting

practices of government entities in our region and has requested a two-year commitment by the					
County to participate and share the cost of this study; and,					
WHEREAS, the County's share of this commitment is \$150,000.00, spread over two years and funds					
for this commitment were included in the 2015 Jackson County budget; and,					
WHEREAS, participation in this disparity study is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare					
of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,					
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Director of					
Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to issue a check to the City of Kansas City,					
Missouri, in the amount of \$75,000.00 for partial funding of a disparity study related to Women- and					
Minority-owned businesses.
