A RESOLUTION recognizing September 28, 2015, through October 4, 2015 as Diaper Need Awareness Week in Jackson County.

RESOLUTION NO. 18903, August 17, 2015

INTRODUCED BY Tony Miller, County Legislator

WHEREAS, diaper need, the condition of not having a sufficient supply of clean diapers to ensure that infants and toddlers are clean, healthy, and dry, can adversely affect the health and welfare of infants, toddlers, and their families; and,

WHEREAS, national surveys report that one in three mothers experiencing diaper need at some time while their children are less than three years of age and forty-eight percent of families delay changing a diaper to extend their supply; and,

WHEREAS, the average infant or toddler requires an average of 50 diaper changes per week over

three years; and,

WHEREAS, since diapers cannot be bought with food stamps or WIC vouchers, obtaining a sufficient

supply of diapers can cause economic hardship to families; and,

WHEREAS, a supply of diapers is generally an eligibility requirement for infant and toddlers to

participate in childcare and quality early education programs; and,

WHEREAS, the citizens of Jackson County recognize that addressing diaper need can lead to

economic opportunity for the state's low-income families and to improved health for families and their

communities; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County is proud to be home to various community organizations that recognize

the importance of diapers in helping provide economic stability for families and distribute diapers to

poor families through various channels; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature

hereby proclaims the week of September 28, 2015, through October 4, 2015, as Diaper Need

Awareness Week in Jackson County and encourages all citizen to donate generously to those

organizations that distribute diapers to families in need.
