WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has certain tactical equipment that the Office is no longer using and

has determined is obsolete; and,

WHEREAS, the Orrick Police Department desires to utilize this equipment and has requested the

donation and transfer of this obsolete personal property; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the transfer of this personal property, pursuant to section 1137.2 Jackson County Code, 1984; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the equipment items within the Sheriff's Office, further described and itemized in Exhibit A, be and hereby are declared surplus, and that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to donate and transfer titles of this surplus property to the Orrick Police Department, pursuant to chapter 11, Jackson County Code, 1984.
