WHEREAS, the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force has received a grant from the United States

Office of National Drug Control Policy, High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) program in the

amount of \$75,000.00, to provide funding for undercover operations by detectives working with the Drug Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the grant is awarded for the period of January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Missouri State Highway Patrol will serve as the fiscal agent for this grant; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place these grant funds in the appropriate spending accounts; now therefore,
