WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office is in need of technical assistance related to the No

Violence Alliance Focused Deterrence/Group Violence Intervention Program, to assist with data

collection, analysis, and interpretation of data; and,

WHEREAS, section 1030.7 of the <u>Jackson</u> <u>County</u> <u>Code</u>, 1984, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when items or services required are proposed to be obtained from a tax-exempt organization; and,

WHEREAS, the University of Missouri - Kansas City (UMKC) has the experience and qualifications needed to provide this service; and,

WHEREAS, an Agreement with UMKC for the furnishing of this technical assistance is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute an Agreement with the UMKC, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement.
