WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office has requested, and the U.S. Department of Justice has approved, an extension of this grant through September 30, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the requested extension will allow for the continuation of funding for salary and benefits

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the 2013 Justice

are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to the extension.
