ORDINANCE NO. 4921, October 31, 2016

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4865, dated July 18, 2016, the Legislature authorized the acceptance of a grant provided by the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) to conduct a joint federal drug investigation in conjunction with the Jackson County Drug Task Force, OCDETF Case No. WC-MOW-306, Operation Squeaky Banjo, for the period of October 1, 2015, through September

30, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the OCDETF has authorized additional funding for the reimbursement of overtime in the amount of \$975.00 related to this grant; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the additional funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,
