## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**AN ORDINANCE** repealing Schedule IV to Chapter 2, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, relating to the salaries of County associates not within the Merit System, and enacting, in lieu thereof, one new schedule relating to the same subject.

**ORDINANCE NO. 4924, October 31, 2016** 

INTRODUCED BY Alfred Jordan, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, under the recommendation of the Human Resources Department, desires to move a senior management staff position from a merit-based classification to a position within its non-merit schedule in the County code; and,

WHEREAS, this recommendation is based on the expanded duties and responsibilities of this position within the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section A. <u>Enacting Clause</u>. Schedule IV to Chapter 2, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, is hereby repealed, and one new schedule enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Schedule IV, to read as follows:
