AN ORDINANCE repealing Schedule III to Chapter 2, Jackson County Code, 1984, relating to the salaries of County associates not within the Merit System, enacting, in lieu thereof, one new schedule relating to the same subject.

ORDINANCE NO. 5037, October 23, 2017

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Legislative Auditor recommends the creation of three new positions on her staff, as well as modest adjustments to the ranges for two other positions, which require a revision to Schedule III to Chapter 2, Jackson County Code, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds the necessary code revision to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Enacting Clause. Schedule III to Chapter 2, Jackson County, 1984, is hereby repealed, and one new schedule enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Schedule III, to read as follows:
