the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for statistical reporting of opioid and violent

deaths; and,

WHEREAS, under the agreement, the County will be reimbursed for providing reports of opioid and

violent deaths through August 31, 2018, in an amount not to exceed \$13,020.00; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Program Agreement sets out the rights and obligations of each party participating in the program; and,

WHEREAS, execution of the attached agreement with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Program Services Contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Citizens. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
