RESOLUTION NO. 19886, June 4, 2018

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19843, dated April 23, 2018, the Legislature did authorize agreement with

certain providers for the furnishing of anti-drug and anti-violent crime treatment programs; and

WHEREAS, upon review, it appears that the proper name of a certain provider was misstated in that

Resolution, such that a portion of the Resolution should be rescinded and reenacted; and,

WHEREAS, the Drug Commission recommends that the portion of Resolution 19843 awarding

\$46,000.00 to the Eastern Jackson County School Collaborative be rescinded and be re-awarded to Blue Springs School District; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute an agreement with Blue Springs School District for anti-drug treatment services, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$46,000.00; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the portion of Resolution 19843 dated April 23, 2018 that awarded a contract to the Eastern Jackson County School Collaborative, be and hereby is rescinded.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
