ORDINANCE NO. 5194, January 22, 2019

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Task Force (JCETF) and the U.S. Department of Justice's Drug Enforcement Administration have formed the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) to conduct a joint federal drug investigation, OCDETF Case No. WC-KS-0214, "Operation

Holy Trojan,” for the period of October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the overtime costs incurred by the JCETF for this investigation will be reimbursed by the OCETF, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the projected funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the undesignated fund balance of the 2019 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund be and hereby is made:
