ORDINANCE NO. 5378, July 27, 2020

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has received a grant from the U.S. Office of Justice Programs to

fund the purchase of equipment to be used by the Sex Offender Registration Enforcement Unit in

connection with the ongoing Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, the funding from this grant will allow the Sex Offender Registration Enforcement Unit to conduct required offender registration with increased social distancing and/or in alternate locations during the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, this grant does not require matching funds and its term expires on January 31, 2022; now therefore,
