RESOLUTION NO. 20814, November 12, 2021

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater III Theresa Cass Galvin, and Jeanie Lauer, County Legislators

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20806, dated November 1, 2021, extended the County's mask mandate order (the "Renewed Public Health Order") until November 22, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the County's COVID-19 cases are declining in eastern Jackson County, Missouri, with an 8% positivity rate which is below the 10% threshold, as reported by the Jackson County Health

Department; and,
NATIFIER AC according to the COVID deals be and moduled by the Mid America Degice of Covid-
WHEREAS, according to the COVID dashboard produced by the Mid-America Regional Council,
daily average new cases of COVID-19 in eastern Jackson County are well below peak levels
reported in August 2021; and,
WHEREAS, it is strongly encouraged that those who are not eligible to be vaccinated, including
children and people who are immunocompromised, continue to wear a mask in public; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as authorized by section
67.265.2, RSMo, that the Renewed Public Health Order be and hereby is terminated upon the
adoption of this Resolution.
Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
