WHEREAS, by Resolution 20841, dated December 13, 2021, the Legislature awarded an eleven-

month contract with two twelve-month options to extend Fred Dreiling, LLC, of Kansas City (Jackson

County) MO, to serve as the Legislature's Chief Lobbyist; and,

WHEREAS, in this capacity, the Chief Lobbyist's responsibilities include assessing the current

political climate in the State of Missouri, recommending appropriate strategies that would benefit the

County, informing the Legislature on all pertinent legislative issues, and providing lobbying service as

requested; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to support "Blair's Law" Missouri Senate Bill 343 which

establishes that a person who commits the offense of unlawful discharge of a firearm within or into

municipal limits that such person shall be guilty of a Class A Misdemeanor for the first offense, a

Class E Felony for the second offense, and a Class D Felony for any third or subsequent offenses;

and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to advocate for common sense gun reform that allows

for greater local control mechanism to reduce gun violence and protect survivors and victims of

domestic abuse; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature expresses the intent to develop a plan regarding lobbyist priorities to

include advocating to the Missouri General Assembly for greater local control for Counties to make

more restrictive and responsive policies in regarding to gun violence and gun laws; now therefore,

hereby direct the Chief Lobbyist to advocate in support of greater local control in regard to gun
violence and safety.
