WHEREAS, Operation Breakthrough, Inc.'s Youth Empowerment program is a peer mentor/leadership development program for at-risk urban youth designed to improve reading skills, academic performance, and self-esteem thereby reducing at-risk behaviors such as substance abuse, crime, and violence; and,

WHEREAS, Operation Breakthrough has requested \$23,936.00 in anti-drug sales tax funds to partially fund this program; and,

WHEREAS, these funds will be used as a local match to a grant from LINC in the amount of \$35,904.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed this proposal and recommends the expenditure of these funds; now therefore,
