IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION transferring \$20,000.00 within the 2015 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund and authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements with certain outside agencies which engage in anti-drug and anti-violent crime related activities, to provide a local match to federal, state, local, and/or private grant funds, at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$962,000.00.

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended that the County Executive be

authorized to execute agreements with certain outside agencies engaged in anti-drug and anti-violent

crime law enforcement, treatment, and prevention activities, requiring a local match to grant funds,

for services from January 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission's applications are based on reviews by independent evaluators of applications submitted by the outside agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies, in the amounts indicated on the document attached hereto as_Exhibit A, is in the best interest of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer is necessary to place a portion of the funds needed in the proper spending

account; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer within the 2015 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund be and hereby is made:
