**A RESOLUTION** authorizing the County Counselor to settle the employment claims of Anthony S. Kweku for the total payment by the County of \$110,000.00.

WHEREAS, although the County denies any wrongdoing, after a thorough investigation and negotiations, the County Counselor recommends a settlement in the amount of \$110,000.00, in exchange for the full and complete release of all claims, to be paid to Mr. Kweku and his attorney, Lynne Bratcher; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed settlement will limit the County's financial obligation in this matter and is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the settlement of the claims of Anthony Kweku, as recommended by the County Counselor, be and hereby is approved; and,
