IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive and the Prosecuting Attorney to execute a twelvemonth Agreement with three twelve-month options to extend, with the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services (MOPS) for an automated case management and criminal history reporting system, at an annual cost to the County not to exceed \$29,190.14.

INTRODUCED BY Alfred Jordan, County Legislator

WHEREAS, section 56.750, RSMo, authorizes the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services (MOPS)

to develop an automated case management system and provide that service to Missouri prosecuting

attorney's offices; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Prosecuting Attorney's Office desires to enter into an agreement with MOPS to utilize this automated case management system; and,

WHEREAS, the County is authorized for 104 users of the System at a total annual cost to the County not to exceed \$29,190.14; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Agreement with the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services is a suitable mechanism by which to implement the mutual agreements of the parties; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of this agreement is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare

of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Agreement with the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services a cost to the County not to exceed \$29,190.14; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement and extensions thereto.

..Enacted and Approved Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
