## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** awarding a twenty-four month term and supply contract, with two twelve-month options to extend, for the furnishing of certified laboratory urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office and the Office of Population Control to Phamatech Inc., of San Diego, CA, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals No. 43-15.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited written proposals pursuant to Request for Proposals No. 43-15 for certified laboratory urinallysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office and the Office of Population Control; and,

WHEREAS, a total of twelve notifications were distributed and four responses were received, one of which was determined to be non-responsive, and the remaining responses evaluated as follows:

experience, qualifications, references, and pricing; and,

WHEREAS, the Director recommends the award to Phamatech of San Diego, CA, as the lowest and

best bid as determined by the evaluation committee; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay

any specific amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases subject to annual

appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as

recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be and hereby is

authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is

authorized to make all payments on the contract, including final payment, to the extent that sufficient

appropriations to the using spending agencies are available in the then current Jackson County

budget.
