WHEREAS, the growing congregation has expanded and improved its facilities under the leadership of Pastor Allen, Sr., for 49 years, and upon his retirement, Pastor Preston Allen, Jr., was appointed; and,

WHEREAS, presently, Macedonia Baptist Church is led by Pastor John Leslie Brooks at its current and fourth location, 1700 E. Linwood Boulevard; and,

WHEREAS, Macedonia Baptist Church serves through a holistic ministry that will reach the lost and minister to the local and international community; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature hereby congratulates Macedonia Baptist Church, on the occasion of its 100th anniversary and extends sincere best wishes for continued success in the future.
