A RESOLUTION awarding a contract on Bid No. PW 11-2016 for the Little Blue Trace Trail Extension, Phase One, Project No. 3208 to Pyramid Contractors, Inc., of Olathe, KS, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$813,249.15, including a five percent contingency, and authorizing the Director of Public Works to approve line item adjustments at no additional cost.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17650, dated August 22, 2011, the Legislature did authorize the execution of a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Kansas City, Missouri, to provide for the extension of the Little Blue Trace Trail between Lee's Summit Road and Longview Lake; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4793, dated November 9, 2015, the Legislature did appropriate funds in the amount of \$675,000.00 received from the City of Kansas City, Missouri, to cover the costs of its portion of the Little Blue Trace Trail Extension, Phase One, Project No. 3208; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has solicited formal written bids on Bid No. PW 11-2016 for this project; and,
