A RESOLUTION awarding eight-year agricultural leases for the planting and harvesting of hay and crops on County park land to Mershon Cattle, LLC, of Lee's Summit, MO, and Barker Farms of Lone Jack, MO, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals 59-16, for specified rents payable to the County.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited formal written bids on Request for Proposals 59-16 for the lease of County park land for the planting and harvesting of hay and crops; and,

WHEREAS, a total of twenty-five notifications were distributed and four responses were received; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that the leases be divided and awarded to the bidders submitting the highest and best bid for each parcel under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals 59-16; and,

WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in the award to the respective bidders as follows:
