**A RESOLUTION** authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year extension to the U.S. Department of Justice Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program Grant, at no cost to the County.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 20504**, September 28, 2020

**INTRODUCED BY** Charlie Franklin, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 5115, dated July 16, 2018, the Legislature did appropriate funds in acceptance of the 2017 Byrne Justice Assistance (JAG) Grant; and,

WHEREAS, this extension will allow for the continued partial funding of one data and information analyst for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has recommended a one-year extension of the grant period to allow for the continued distribution of grant funds to the City of Kansas City, MO, for the Neighborhood & Services, Graffiti Abatement, and Kansas City No Violence Alliance program areas; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that a one-year extension to the JAG Grant be and is hereby is approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all County officials be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to give effect to this extension.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
