## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** recognizing the risk and negative impacts of overreliance on property taxes to fund critical governmental functions.

**RESOLUTION NO. 21225,** April 3, 2023

INTRODUCED BY Sean E. Smith, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County relies upon both personal and real property taxes as principal sources of revenue; and,

WHEREAS, numerous items of legislation contemplate eliminating or reducing property tax revenues received by local taxing jurisdictions; and,

WHEREAS, current Missouri property tax law and processes result in considerable negative effects on the County's citizens, including financial hardship and potential for foreclosures and evictions; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County Question 1 on the ballot for the upcoming April 4 special election, a County-wide sales tax on sales of non-medicinal marijuana, may represent a substantial new revenue source whose amount cannot yet be determined; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to reduce its reliance on personal property taxes
